

What type of software do I need in order to view documents at this site?

Most of the bookform documents available for downloading are in PDF (Portable Document Format). Adobe Acrobat Reader is a popular PDF viewer that can be used on Windows or Macintosh platforms. For more information on obtaining this viewer for personal use, check out the [Adobe](#) website.

Engineering drawings and other large documents available for downloading are in multi-page TIFF (Tagged Image File Format). There are several viewers capable of visually presenting TIFF documents, including Imaging for Windows.

(C:\WINDOWS\KODAKIMG.EXE for Windows 95/98; and
C:\Program Files\Windows NT\Accessories\ImageVue\kodaking.exe for Windows 2000)

Numerous companies provide programs capable of viewing TIFF files if you don't have Imaging for Windows on your computer.

Irfanview is a free image viewer available from [Tucows](#).

TMSSequoia also provides a TIFF viewer for the Windows platforms. For more information go to the [TMSSequoia](#) Website.

There is also a free (it requires a one-time registration over the Internet) browser plug-in that enables both Netscape and Internet Explorer to view TIFF files available at <http://www.alternatiff.com/>.

Graphic Converter is a popular viewer for the Macintosh platform. It is able to read and manipulate TIFF files. For more information on this viewer see:
